Children Arriving Late

We are seeing an increasing number of children arriving late for school — sometimes as much as an hour, with some children arriving late every day. Lessons start at 9am and these children are missing essential learning. We teach Phonics at 9 o'clock across school and this is the most important lesson of the day — learning to read is the foundation of all learning. Please work with us to get your child into school on time. School is not optional, once children are in reception you have a legal duty to send your child into school each and every day.

Supervising Children

Please ensure that an adult brings your child all the way into school and drops at the appropriate gate, or if they are late, to the school office. Children should not be left alone at any point – inappropriate supervision is a safeguarding issue and will be dealt with accordingly.

Flu Immunisation

The school nursing team will be in school on Monday 13th November to give your child their flu immunisation (nasal spray).

Please make sure that you complete and submit your child's consent form as soon as you get it, whether you wish your child to be vaccinated or not and **only submit one consent form per child**. The form can be accessed here: Home | Forms (mpft.nhs.uk)

Consents Forms must be submitted by 10am on Friday 10th November 2023, as we are unable to accept them after this date. You may be required to bring your child to a community clinic for a catch-up appointment, if you do not submit the consent form by the required date above.
