Well done to Ladybird class who had the most raffle tickets this week! They will have some extra playtime and will keep the Class of the Week trophy next week.

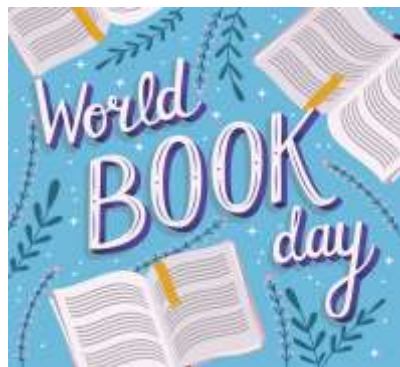
Parents Evening
